

## VERONIKA LAVHEY h.Art EMERGING ARTIST BURSARY

Veronika Lavey often felt like a misfit, it's led her to creating artwork that is concerned with depicting strength and resilience in the face of the situations and hardship she has often felt her way through. Veronika was born in Hungary then lived most of her teens in Los Angeles and New Zealand. She's been living in the UK since 2004, and have called Herefordshire home since 2010.



Veronika's medium is fine art photography, using conceptual imagery and digital manipulation. A self-portrait artist, she is a theatrical or an autobiographical character playing out stories. Inspiration can be a thought, a dream, frequently a poem. She writes poetry herself and they often sit behind her images, some found in an accomplished, self-published book.

The practical process behind creating Veronika's image: sourcing of props and creation of her costumes, finding the right location, pose and always an overcast day. Her camera sits on a tripod and is connected to her phone for more control. Veronika's favourite part is playing with the shots in post processing. She draws on her complicated looking computer screen and plays with colours, light and anything required to make the image tell a story.

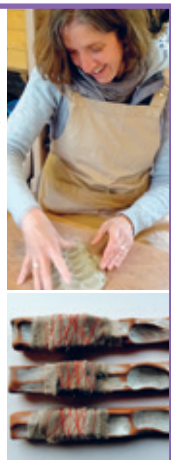


## Hannah Day h.Art Emerging Artist Bursary

**Hannah Day h.Art Emerging Artist Bursary winner, is coming to the conclusion of her MA in Contemporary Craft.** Her work is currently in the exploratory stage using ceramics and textiles to process her ideas into 3D samples, with her focus on her final show. 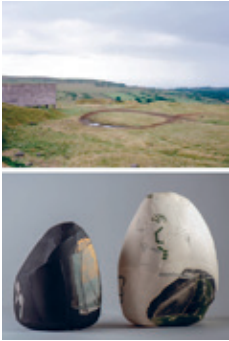
